


**Willow Beck Path

Building work starts on public toilets

WORK is starting on one of the most anticipated recent developments in Northallerton, with local construction company Moody Ltd, moving into the town hall to create new public toilets.

It is hoped the new facilities will open in early May ready for the summer.

A public survey was carried out last year by Northallerton Town Council alongside local businesses and community groups, and people backed separate male and female toilets plus an accessible facility with baby changing.

James Moody, construction director, said: "As a 100-year-old business established and based here in Northallerton we are passionate about supporting improvements to the area in which we live and work.

"We are pleased to continue our strong partnership with the local councils to provide much needed high-quality facilities and amenities within and around our wonderful market town, these latest sympathetic alterations to the town hall will create public conveniences on the High Street for both residents of, and visitors to Northallerton."

The new toilets will be based at the north end of the Grade II-listed hall, taking up the ground floor currently used as two shops.

Northallerton Town Council has been pushing for the new public toilets in the High Street amid increasing demand, and said it is confident the facilities will enhance the visitor experience to the town, supporting the redevelopment of the town square and moves to encourage coach parties.

The new public toilets have been backed with successful grant bids and with the help of Hambleton District Council's BounceBack fund. Cllr Paul Cornfoot, deputy mayor, said: "It has become increasingly clear over the past few years, that Northallerton needs good quality, accessible and centrally located public toilets in the town.

"We have worked closely with the local community and key stakeholders to ensure that the new facility will further improve the attractiveness of the town for residents, businesses and visitors, which is crucial to help the local economy after a few difficult years."





