There will be highly visible and covert police officers alongside other resources such as police dogs, automatic number plate recognition deployment, firearms officers and CCTV. 	Great results  Over the last few weeks we have had some excellent results which I would like to share with you – The male responsible for the £441,640 Bradleys Jewellery Robbery on 11 <sup>th</sup> March 2019, 38 year old Victor Okumu from Middlesbrough, was found guilty at court on 12 <sup>th</sup> July and was sentenced to 10 years and 6 months imprisonment. The judge commented that this had taken a very dangerous man off our streets. Following a number of vehicles being attacked in Brompton a male was arrested near to the scene and has subsequently been charged with theft from motor vehicle and vehicle interference. A drugs warrant was executed at an address in Bullamoor Close, Northallerton resulting in a male being arrested on suspicion of drugs offences.
