

## Minutes of an Engagement & Events Committee Meeting of Northallerton Town Council held at 10:00 on Friday 6th June in the Town Hall

EE25/01 To elect a Chairman for the Engagement and Events Committee 2025/2026

It was resolved that CIIr S Bell will be the Chairman for the Engagement and Events Committee 2025/2026

EE25/02 To receive and consider Apologies for Absence and Declarations of Interest It was resolved that apologies be received and accepted from ClIr S Barber

EE25/03 To consider if it is necessary to resolve to exclude members of the press and public by virtue of Public (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960, due to the confidential nature of any agenda items

It was resolved that it was not necessary to exclude members of the press and public

EE25/04 To approve the Minutes of the Engagement and Events Committee Meeting held on 21st March 2025 It was resolved that Minutes of the Engagement and Events Committee Meeting 21st March 2025 be approved

EE25/05 To review the Engagement and Events Committee Terms of Reference for approval at Full Council It was agreed that the approved Terms of Reference are still appropriate for the Committee

EE25/06 To receive an update and agree next steps for the Christmas Event 2025

The Clerk gave an update on the plans for the Christmas Event which will take place on 13th December and lead into the Tractor Parade. Liaison between Little Bird Markets, Viking Productions and North Yorkshire County Show is ongoing. Engagement with businesses on Zetland Street and Treadmills including Everyman will take place in the coming month, as the format is developed.

It was resolved that the Clerk will progress this event plan

EE25/07 To consider the Councils response to NYC Local Plan consultation regarding future land use in Northallerton Discussion took place regarding the ongoing consultation for the new Local Plan. An online document has been reviewed requesting comments at each stage.

Northallerton and Romanby are key service centres and are 4th in the tier of settlements after Harrogate; Scarborough and Selby. It was felt that Brompton should also be included in this to reflect the need for active travel and transport to be incorporated in these plans.

- 2. It was resolved that the Town Council will submit a full response to this consultation

EE25/08 To receive an update on the development of the new school on the former Grammar School site A report had been received from the Department for Education about the progress of this school.

Councillors are concerned that this project will not be delivered, which will impact on local education provision and the space will remain unused. Councillors are keen to express disappointment in this reply and wish to understand the position of NYC on the matter and also that of the MP.

It was resolved that Northallerton Town Council will write to the Leader of NYC and Rishi Sunak MP requesting their views

EE25/09 To consider the York & North Yorks Mayor grant programme for vibrancy & sustainability and agree actions A letter from the Council to the Mayor and key officers at NYC, BID and other stakeholders included in the discussions had been drafted encouraging the Mayor's office to engage with towns regarding the spending of any grants awarded.

EE25/12 To consider promotional materials needed for councillors to take part in a Community Action Day It was resolved that Cllr Cornfoot will put together some material using the Annual Report to be transferred to display boards

EE25/13 To receive a gift of a Green Plaque, celebrating an event in Northallerton and consider steps needed to secure this in an appropriate location

A green plaque had been donated to the Town Council celebrating the visit of the Sex Pistols to a Northallerton venue. It was resolved that the Clerk will write to the owner of the building to request permission to erect this and arrange an unveiling event

EE25/14 To consider and agree how NTC will commemorate VJ Day 2025, 15th August 2025

It was resolved that the Mayor will lay a Wreath followed by refreshments at the Town Hall

It was noted that the flag will be raised on 23rd June for Armed Forces Day and the flag will be in position for a week.
