FC25/10 To receive and consider Apologies for Absence and Declarations of Interest All councillors were present.

FC25/13 To agree to write off two outstanding invoices for hire of the Town Hall

Two small Town Hall hire payments with a combined value of £80 have not been received and the Finance Officer has spent a disproportionate amount of time following this up with the hirers.

It was resolved that the Finance Officer should no longer chase up these outstanding payments and that, if they are not paid by financial year end, they will be written off

FC25/14 To consider costs of maintenance contracts for Fire, CCTV and Intruder Alarms and agree next steps A quote for like for like cover had been researched but councillors would prefer some form of Emergency Response to be included in the package.
